During their 9-day visit they preached in 3 churches, taught seminars, made new friends and enjoyed wonderful hospitality. Coast conference will be Aug. 10 -12 with 70 expected to attend. 150 are expected at the conference in Meru, Eastern Kenya on Aug. 21-25. Pray these youth will be edified, admonished and encouraged by their fellowship and by the Word of God.

TEAM VIETNAM ➤ Praise the Lord for a ministry motorbike and funds for their children’s studies in the Philippines. Pray they will soon be able to communicate the gospel in the Vietnamese language and be granted a residence permit to stay in the country.
